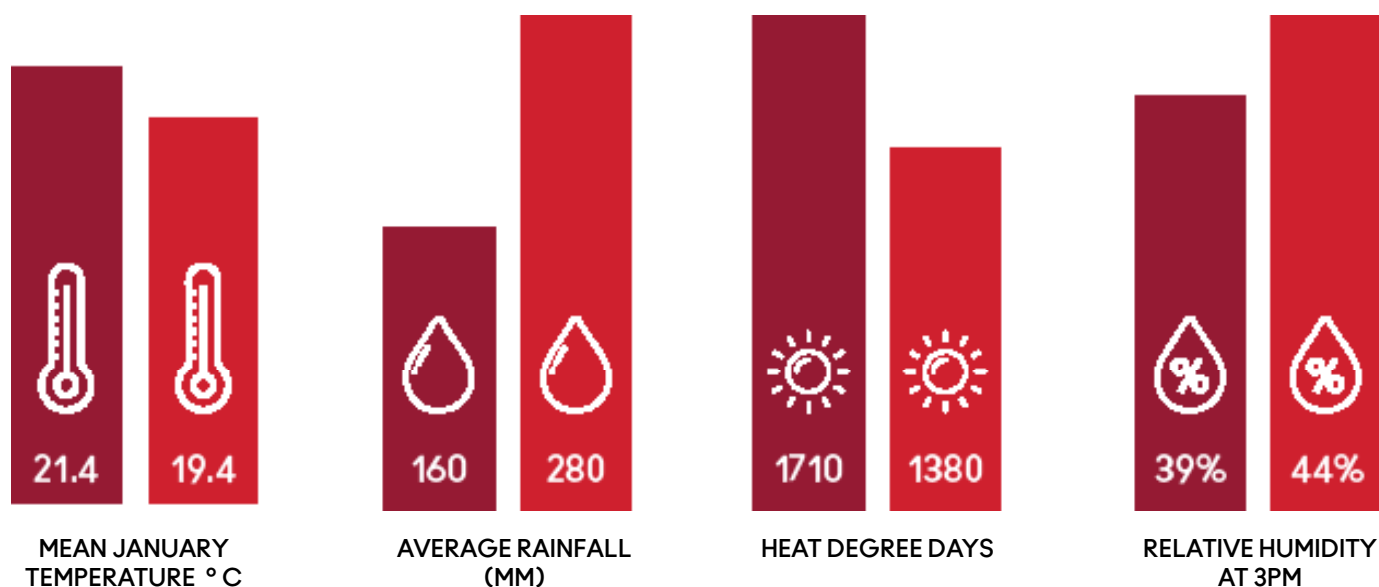


# BAROSSA VALLEY AND EDEN VALLEY SUMMARY

REGION	BAROSSA VALLEY	EDEN VALLEY
<b>Map Coordinates</b>	34° 29' S	34° 35' S
<b>Altitude</b>	112 – 597m (53% < 280m) (367 – 1,959 feet)	217 – 630m (99% > 280m) (712 – 2,067 feet)
<b>Temperature / Ripening</b>	Warm, dry days, cool nights. Plenty of sunshine, with cool nights ensuring consistent ripening, but not too quickly.	Daytime 2 – 3°C cooler than BV. Night time temperatures 5 – 7°C cooler. Slower ripening, cool climate flavours, greater retention of acidity.
<b>Soil</b>	Deep, rich soils.	Shallow, rocky soils.
<b>Viticulture</b>	Vineyards on shallow soils require irrigation, whereas many old vineyards, or those on deeper soils are dry grown.	Many vineyards require irrigation due to poor soil fertility and water retention.
<b>Harvest</b>	Mid-February – Late April	Mid-March – April/Early May
